Checklist of What Can Never Be Shared:

The following information cannot be given out:

- Social Security Number: You cannot give out the student's social security number, you can't post it, you cannot use some or part of this information to confirm a student's identification.
- Citizenship
- Gender
- Ethnicity
- Religious Preference: If you are going to give out the student's religious preference, the student has to be notified and grant permission first.
- Grades
- GPA
- Daily Class Schedule: This is very important. Refer any emergencies to campus security.
- Any concerns or doubts about FERPA regulations? Contact your Registrar's Office.
