

Registrar at Coffeyville Community College

Former KACRAO Member and Community College Registrar Passed Away

Mary Lee (Carson) Breen, 72, former Registrar at Coffeyville Community College passed away September 14, 2013 at Mercy Hospital in Oklahoma City, OK. Mary Lee was born September 12, 1941 in Coffeyville to James Jarile and Mary Lois (Hannah) Carson. She grew up in Coffeyville receiving her high school diploma in 1959 from Field Kindley Memorial High School. She continued her education, receiving her Associate's Degree from Coffeyville Community College in 1961 and earning her Bachelor's Degree from Pittsburg State University in 1963. In 1964 she was united in marriage to Lynn P. Breen. From that union one child, a son, was born. The couple lived in Wichita, KS where she worked for the Litwin Corporation, taught school and co-founded World Wide Construction Services, Inc. The family moved to Fredonia, KS in 1974 where she worked as office manager for a local insurance office. The couple divorced in 1978. Mary Lee returned to Coffeyville where she worked for Funk Manufacturing and then Coffeyville Community College serving as Registrar. She enjoyed watching college football, basketball, keeping up with current events, and spending time with family and friends. She served as the Registrar from 1987 until her retirement in 2003. In the KACRAO organization, she was a mentor to many just starting a career in higher education. To the students, she was the person with all the answers. Surviving to honor her memory is her son, Michael A. Breen, his wife, Alma, and granddaughter Elisabeth of Palmdale, CA. Graveside service was held on September 21 at Fairfield Cemetery in Coffeyville, KS.


Shared Thoughts and Memories
